
# EARLY PREGNANCY INFORMATION

# **Early Pregnancy Unit Information Leaflet**

This data has been collated from various sources and is intended to be used as a resource for anyone needing support in the early stages of a pregnancy; assisted or otherwise. These units provide medical assessment and where needed treatment or guidance. They <u>do not</u> provide emotional support or counselling. This is intended as a guide and is by no means comprehensive. All medical emergencies require immediate attention of the emergency services.

# **Explaining: Pain & Bleeding in Early Pregnancy**

We understand your concerns about having pain and/or bleeding in early pregnancy. We hope this information sheet will provide some information and reassurance to you and your partner. It also informs you what you should do next.

# Introduction

Vaginal bleeding and pain in the early stages of pregnancy is common and does not always mean there is a problem. However, these symptoms can sometimes be warning signs of a miscarriage, ectopic pregnancy or, in rare cases, molar pregnancy. Therefore you will be offered assessment and tests to determine the cause. If all the tests are normal, and no cause for the bleeding has been found, then you need not worry, particularly if your symptoms have subsided.

### Causes

In the majority of cases, investigations will show a normal pregnancy. This is termed a threatened miscarriage where bleeding and pain occurs but the pregnancy is alive. Sometimes, the pain and bleeding result from a miscarriage and the pregnancy is no longer alive. Occasionally, an ectopic pregnancy is found where the pregnancy is growing outside the womb such as in the Fallopian tube. There is a risk of significant bleeding from such pregnancies, and the bleeding may be internal and therefore not easily noticed. It is therefore important that you keep your appointment for follow-up, and/or present for medical attention if you feel unwell, have increase pain or bleeding. Rarely, the symptoms could result from a molar pregnancy where the placenta is abnormal.

# **Symptoms**

You may experience bleeding, pain or both. If you miscarry, you may pass out the pregnancy in addition to blood and blood clots. It will be useful to bring this in in a safely sealed container for the doctor or nurse to examine. If you feel unwell, dizzy or experience severe pain or bleeding, you should seek medical attention immediately.
